

APPLICANT IDENTITY REQUIREMENTS

Australian National Police Check applicants need to provide identification against the following categories:

1 X COMMENCEMENT OF IDENTITY

- Full Australian Birth Certificate or authorised record of birth (not an extract or birth card)
- Current Australian Passport (not expired)
- Australian Work Rights check which you will complete in the WorkPro online portal as part of the Police Check application
- An ImmiCard issued by the Department of Home Affairs
- Australian Citizenship Certificate

1 X PRIMARY USE IN THE COMMUNITY DOCUMENT

- Current Australian Passport (unless you used your Passport as a Commencement of Identity document)
- ImmiCard issued by the Department of Home Affairs (unless you used your ImmiCard as a Commencement of Identity document)
- Current Australian drivers licence, learner permit or provisional licence issued by a State or Territory, showing your signature and/or photo and the same name as claimed
- Current Passport issued by a country other than Australia, with a valid entry stamp or visa
- Current proof of age or photo identity card issued by an Australian Government Agency in the name of the applicant, including your signature and photo
- For persons under 18 years of age with no other Primary Use in the Community Document - a student identity document issued by an Australian government agency or Australian school only

2 X CURRENT SECONDARY USE IN THE COMMUNITY DOCUMENTS

- Current Medicare card
- Bank card (showing only name and expiry date. You do not need to show payment card numbers)
- Credit card (showing only name and expiry date. You do not need to show payment card numbers)
- Credit reference check
- Commonwealth or State/Territory government photo identity card (this may take the form of a working with children or vulnerable people card or a government issued occupational licence (e.g. High Risk Licence))
- Evidence of right to an Australian government benefit (Centrelink or Veterans' Affairs)
- Enrolment with Australian Electoral Commission
- Australian tertiary or secondary student photo identity document
- Certified academic transcript from an Australian university
- Aviation security identification card
- Maritime security identification card
- Police Force Officer photo identity card
- Australian Defence Force photo identity card
- Security Guard/Crowd Control photo licence
- Foreign government-issued documents (e.g. driver's licence. Documents in languages other than English must be accompanied by a NAATI accredited translation)
- DFAT issued Certificate or Document of Identity
- DFAT issued United Nations Convention Travel Document Secondary
- DFAT issued Consular photo identity card
- Trusted referee report
- Firearms licence
- Australian Government Tax File Number (upload the official Government document that shows your name, address and TFN)
